

Employer Partner Program

Make an Impact. Empower Tomorrow's Workforce.

WHAT TO EXPECT

When you partner with PYN, you can count on receiving motivated, pre-screened, and pre-trained young people who are ready to contribute and grow.

Our participants come prepared with the foundational skills, workplace readiness training, and career development support needed to succeed within a professional environment.

PYN works directly with each Employer Partner to design and customize youth work experiences that fit your organization's needs while ensuring young people gain meaningful, structured career exposure.

While every placement is flexible, most follow a standard format:

- Typical Program Length: 6–8 weeks (seasonal cohorts throughout the year)
- Typical Intern Hours: ~120 total hours, structured to align with your workplace schedule.
- Sample Schedule:
 - Worksite: Mon, Wed, Thu | 12-5pm
 - Professional Development: Fri | 9–1pm





HOW IT WORKS

Partnering with PYN is a guided, collaborative process designed to make hosting youth simple and impactful. Here's how our Employer Partner process typically works:

- Apply: Submit a quick worksite application to outline roles and supervision.
- Onboard: Meet with PYN's Business Engagement Team to confirm details, sign a "worksite agreement" and customize your partnership.
- Prepare: Supervisors receive orientation, submit state-mandated clearances, and receive PYN training + resources for hosting youth.
- Start: Pre-screened, motivated youth arrive onsite for their first day.
- Support: PYN provides HR support, payroll, coaching, and site visits throughout the program.
- Evaluate: Share feedback, complete surveys, and share metrics to strengthen future experiences.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Are these paid opportunities?

Yes - PYN works with a network of local funders and corporate partners to sponsor youth payments up to \$15/hr.

Do employer partners have to pay?

Not usually - though we welcome those willing to support our programs. Employers that sponsor interns are guaranteed placements.

How many interns can I host?

There's no maximum - most employers host 2–5 interns, with a minimum of 1, depending on your business size.

Can I bring in an intern I already know?

Yes! PYN will guide onboarding and training.

Who supports me during the program?

PYN's Business Engagement + Career Coaching team work directly with your staff and youth interns.

What kind of should interns do?

Interns can take on administrative, project-based, or hands-on tasks that fit your organization's needs.

What if challenges come up during the placement?

PYN's staff and Career Coaches provide support and troubleshooting to keep the experience positive.
