General Description:

The Evaluation Specialist is a member of the Research and Evaluation team and primarily responsible for the successful implementation of the WorkReady Summer evaluation plan. This individual will support the development of an evaluation plan, assist with the development and fielding of surveys and assessment tools, collect qualitative data through interviews and focus groups with staff and participants, provide technical assistance to providers for successful completion of surveys and assessments, and analyze quantitative and qualitative data about the program.

Essential Functions:

- Support the development of a comprehensive evaluation plan for WorkReady Summer
- Oversee workplan for implementing WorkReady Summer evaluation strategies – including roll out of assessments tools and surveys
- Support the fielding of new assessment tools and surveys, including coordinating with providers
- Help develop provider materials for communicating about the evaluation plan
- Schedule calls with providers as needed, manage and support providers to field surveys and assessments
- Work with R&E staff to operationalize youth development frameworks for additional data collection
- Conduct interviews and focus groups to collect qualitative data from provider staff and youth participants
- Specifically, offer special support to other PYN departments team as needed to support evaluation activities

- Experience with surveys and qualitative data collection
